GENERAL RULES

Students willing to take admission in the college in degree course either have to purchase admission form along with prospectus on payment of Rs. 60.00 from the cash counter or to download the same from the college website. A fee of Rs.60.00 will be charged at the time of submission of downloaded form. Two passport size photographs are required at the time of admission, one for admission form and the other for identity card. Commencement of 1st year, 2nd year and 3rd year classes will be started from 21.07.2012.

CHANGE OF SUBJECT OR COURSE & PERCENTAGE OF ATTENDANCE / TRANSFER OF CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION

Under special circumstances change of subject may be allowed within 16th August every year provided duly applied for and on payment of Rs.300.00. But such changes will strictly be guided by the existing University rules. Regular attendance in classes is the must. At least 75% of attendance in the classes is required for appearing any university Examination. These apart, students must appear in all class tests for internal assessment round the year.

Transfer / Cancellation of Admission may be allowed within 25.07.2012 subject to payment of all fees for the 1st year. No Transfer/Cancellation of Admission will be allowed after 25.07.2012.

RULES OF PAYMENT

- No payment is accepted without the Fee-Card, if the Fee-Card is lost Rs.10.00 will be charged for a new one.
- All kinds of fees are received at the cash counter between 10.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. on all working days and on Saturday between 10.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon.
- No transaction of fee is allowed except cash counter. Any breach of this rule is severely punishable.

SUPPORT SERVICE

LIBRARY

Our college library is enriched with near about 17,000 books, current and back volumes of 16 renowned journals and 12 other periodicals. LIBRARY RULES IN BRIEF

RULES

The college has a beautiful hostel with the accommodation of 500 boarders inside the college campus. It is run by the direct supervision and control of the college. There is a hostel committee to look after the interest of the boarders. Boarders are to abide by all the rules and regulations of the Board of Residence, Vidyasagar University. Any violation of rules, must strictly be penalized. Considering the benefits of the students coming from poor and middle class families, the hostel meal charge has been fixed at Rs.450.00 p.m. only excluding the monthly seat rent and

establishment charges of Rs.250.00, for Electric generator charges Rs.25.00 per month. Boarders are to pay all charges in the college cash counter within the first week of every month. Defaulters are to pay a fine of one rupee per day.

Students intending to reside in the Hostel may apply in the prescribed form available in the college office at the cost of Rs.50.00 at the time of their admission in the college. The decision of the Hostel Committee is final regarding admission in the both inside and outside the college and hostel and the extent to which she observes the rules and regulations of the institution. Daily Programme for the boarders and all rules and regulations are subject to changes from time to time.

COACHING CLASS FOR ENTRY IN SERVICES FOR SC/ST/OBC (NON CREAMY LAYER & MINORITIES)

For sustainable development of the nation, special emphasis should be given to the development of the marginalized sections of the society i.e. The Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, OBC and Minorities. With this objective in view, our college has started a coaching scheme to prepare our students belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer) and Minority Communities to get gainful employment in public as well as private sectors. This scheme is funded by UGC.

ADD-ON COURSE IN CLINICAL NUTRITION AND DIETETICS (CND)

We have introduced UGC Funded certificate/Diploma/Advance Diploma in Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics. The department of Nutrition of this college conducts this course. After passing out, the students will get the enormous opportunity of being employed in different hospital and nursing homes in West Bengal and other states. One can pursue this course with their regular courses at the same time. Separate form and Prospectus will be available for this programme on payment of Rs.200/- in the cash counter.

ADD-ON –CERTIFICATE COURSE IN PERFORMING ART (UGC SPONSORED)

Aspiring students may study one year certificate course in performing art such as Dance, Drama and Music with their regular courses as an additional degree. Separate form and prospectus will be available from the Co-ordinating department (Music).

ADD - ON – CERTIFICATE COURSE IN TRAVEL & TOURISM MANAGEMENT (UGC SPONSORED)

One year certificate course in Travel and Tourism Management has been started by the department of History of this college to give our student an orientation to the rising job market in this sector. Form, Prospectus and details of the plan will be available directly from the co-ordinating department. It is also a part of our dual degree programme.

ADD-ON –CERTIFICATE COURSE IN FOOD PROCESSING (UGC SPONSORED)

Food market in our country is gradually diversified and got a momentum of exponential growth. So job market in this sector is rising with the degree of growth of this sector. Nutrition department of this college is started a dual degree programme on one year certificate course on 'Food Processing' with regular Nutrition Honours or Bio-Science Courses. Students with arts back ground may take admission in this course but they have to complete science based topic with their own interest. Detail will be available from the co-ordinating department.

CAREER AND COUNSELLING CELL

We have formed a career and counselling cell with the financial assistance from UGC. This cell provides our students relevant information and professional guidance about the prospects of different types of courses. Hopefully, this help them to face the complex and globalised job market in a better way.

DAY CARE CENTRE

We have formed a day care centre with the financial assistance from UGC. This centre provides our staffs kids medical treatment and recreation facilities within our college all along the day.

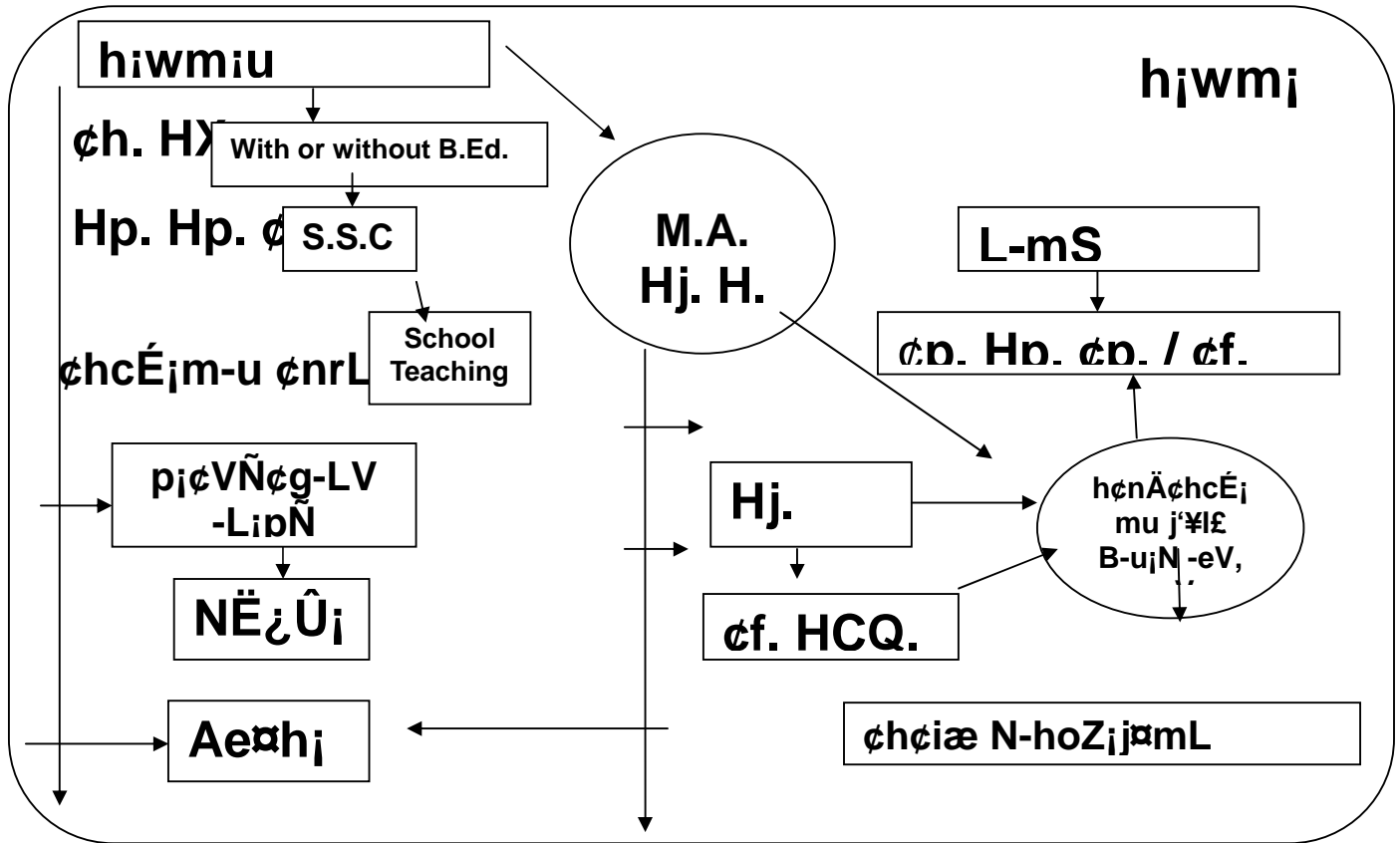

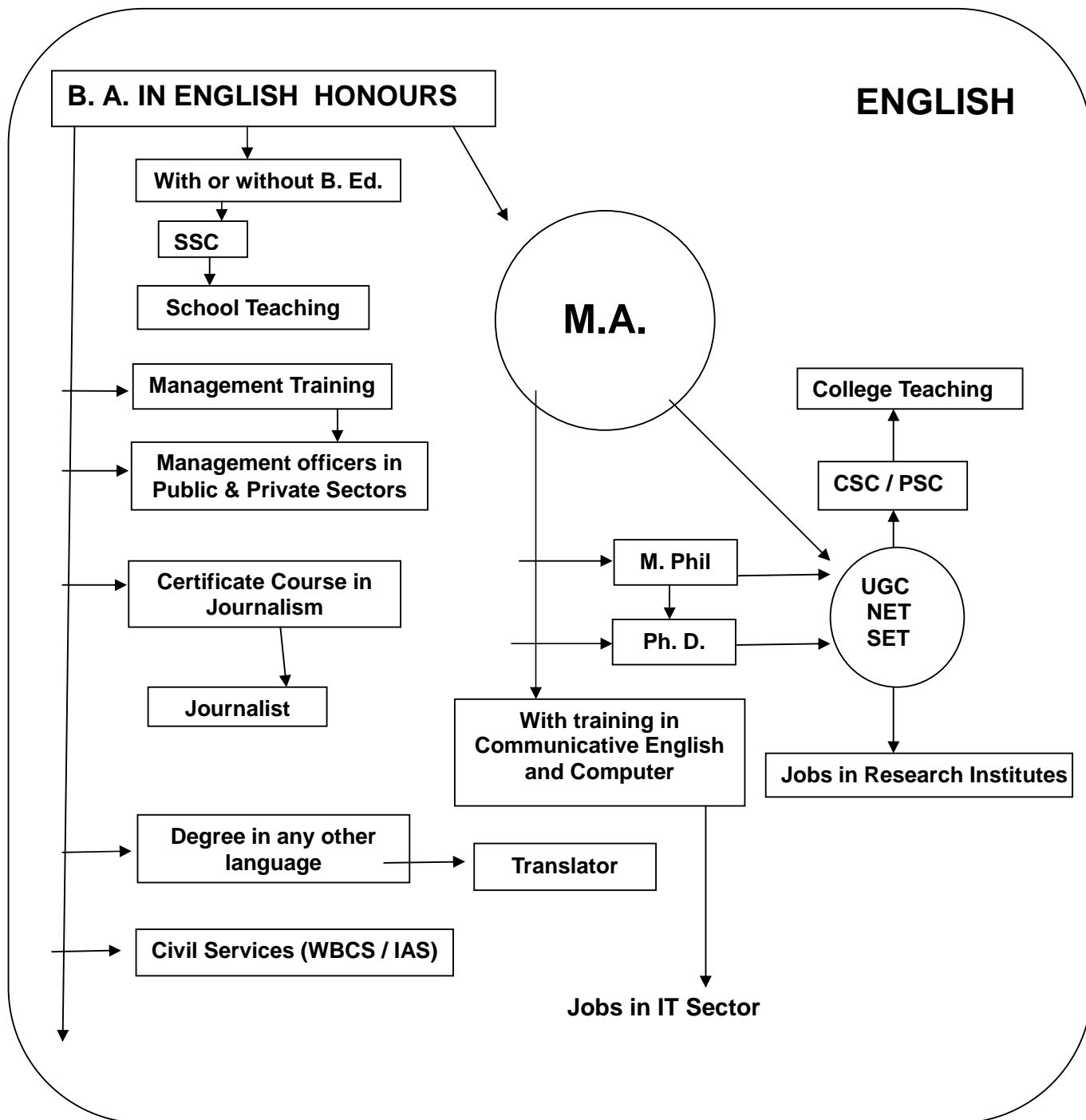

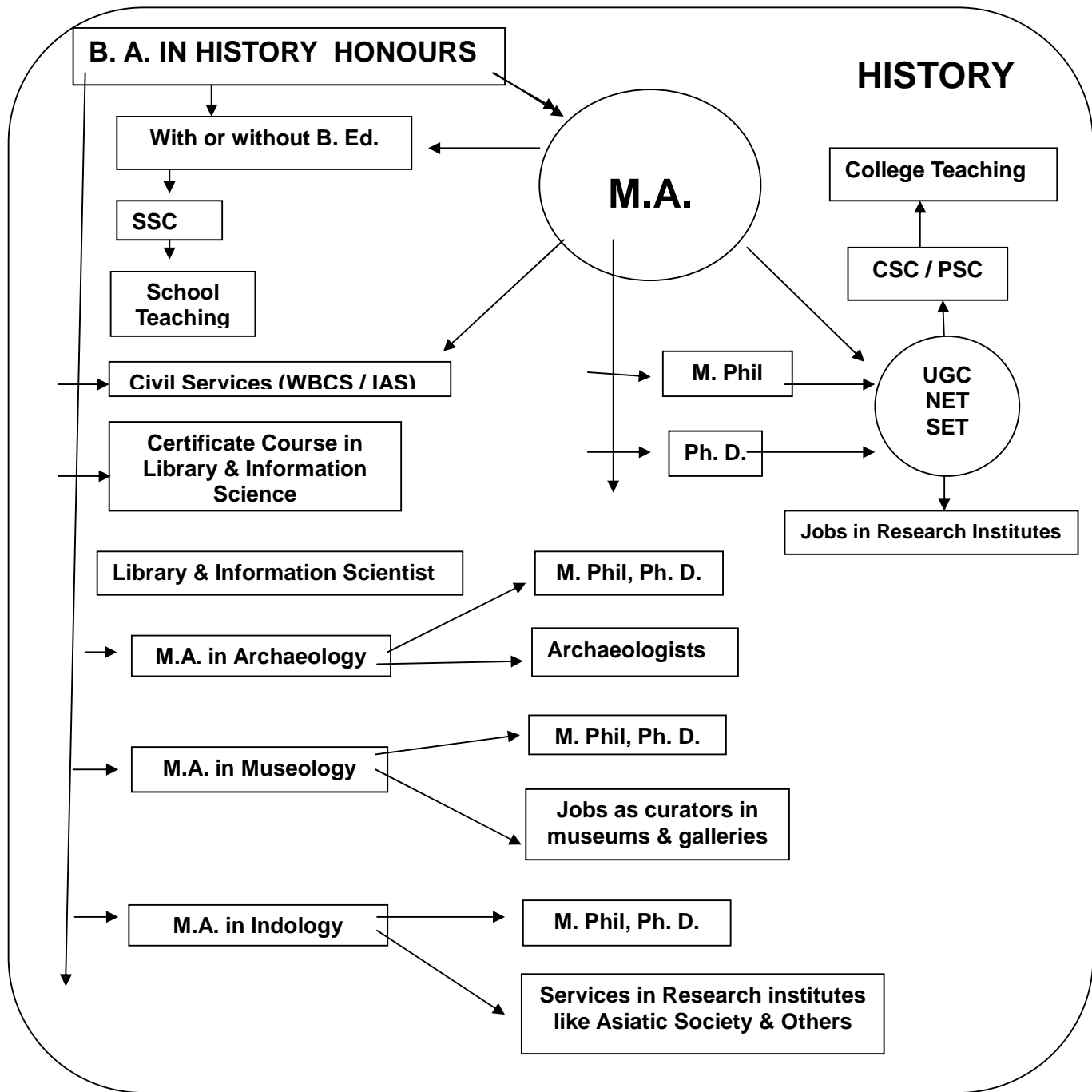
